3. All exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor and be completed by him/her since August 2017, and not shown previously at the La Porte County Fair.
4. Only one exhibit may be entered in a division.
5. ONLY RESIDENTS OF LAPORTE COUNTY MAY EXHIBIT. MINIMUM AGE OF 18 YEARS REQUIRED.
6. All articles will be displayed in the Community Bldg.
7. The Fair Board will not be responsible for theft of articles; however, someone will be in the building whenever it is open. Every possible care will be taken of articles.
8. If there are less than three (3) articles in any class, the exhibit will be placed according to the judge's decision as to quality of work.
9. Exhibits may NOT be removed before Sunday, July 15, 2018. Release times are from 11:00 a.m. - 2:00p.m. Please note that this is the ONLY time you can pick up your items.
10. NOTE: PREMIUM CHECKS FOR PRIZE MONEY WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PICKUP IN THE FAIR OFFICE ON FRIDAY EVENING AND SATURDAY OF FAIR WEEK. (Office is open until 7:00PM each night) CHECKS WILL NOT BE MAILED AND WILL BE FORFEITED AFTER SEPT.15

FOODS – Tuesday, July 10, 2018

*****FOOD SAFETY REGULATION***FROM PURDUE EXTENSION FOOD SAFETY POLICY (revised 11/2013):**

FOR BAKED PRODUCT COMPETITIONS: “Filling, frosting, glazing, pie filling, and meringue, whether uncooked or cooked ARE NOT PERMITTED to contain cream cheese, sour cream, heavy cream or whipped cream as the nature of these products increases the moisture content and water activity of the food. Foods with a higher moisture content and water activity can be ideal for growing conditions for food borne pathogens, even if the ingredient is part of a batter or baked. Additionally, raw milk, raw milk products or uncooked eggs/egg whites are not permitted. Eggs/egg whites that have been cooked to 160 degrees Fahrenheit (i.e. pasteurized or included as part of a batter and baked) are acceptable. No home-canned fruits, vegetables, or meats are permitted in products. Recipes must be provided that show which ingredients were used in each part of the product. Contestants should carefully wash their hands and make sure that their hands do not have any open cuts before preparing foods. Contestants should not be preparing food exhibits for competition within 48 hours of recovering from any illness. Whenever possible, baked products should be transported and stored in chilled coolers (41 degrees Fahrenheit). Judges and individuals who will consume products from county and state competitions should be informed that they are at risk for food borne illness since the established policy cannot guarantee that an entry which is a “potentially hazardous food” has been properly prepared or handled before, during or following competition. Tasting of a food product is solely at the discretion of the judge. Judges are NOT to taste any low-acid or acidified preserved food, like green beans or tomato products, and are discouraged from tasting any other home preserved food. Consumers of competitive food exhibits being sold at auction or used for hospitality purposes should be notified they could be at risk for foodborne illness since the established policy cannot guarantee that any entry which may be a potentially hazardous food has been properly prepared or handled before, during or following the competition.
